



## TIGER WALL PLATINUM SET UP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove contents from stuff sack. Spread out the tent body.
2. Assemble the poleset. Ensure each pole section is fully seated into the next by hand instead of allowing the shock cord to snap them together.
3. Position the assembled poleset on top of the tent body, orienting so the colors of the pole ends match the webbing on the tent body.
4. Insert the pole tips into the keyed slots of the TipLok™ at the head and foot of the tent body.
5. Attach the plastic clips on the tent body to the main pole.
6. Clip the ends of the crossover pole into the plastic "Cross Pole Socket" body connectors that are located on either side of the tent body.
7. Stake out two cord loops at the head of the tent and the three loops at the foot.
8. Drape the rainfly over the tent body, orienting so the colors of the webbing on the rainfly match the webbing on the tent body.
9. Insert the tips of the crossover pole into the "Cross Pole Sockets" located on the underside of the rainfly.
10. Attach all hook and loop tabs on the underside of the rainfly to the corresponding pole sections for best stability.
11. Make sure the webbing at the corners of the rainfly is completely slackened. Attach the buckles on the rainfly to the TipLok™ on the tent body.
12. Tighten the webbing on each buckle as needed to keep the rainfly taut.
13. Stake out both vestibules, then stake out and tension all remaining guylines, completing set up.

**Low Vent Set Up:** For increased ventilation, hook the cord at the bottom of the vestibule door to the toggle at the top of the zipper located on the underside of the fly.

**Separate pole splint included for emergency field repair. Slide repair pole over the break to act as a splint. Secure splint in place with tape.**

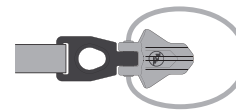

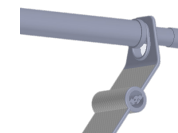
## FAST FLY SET UP INSTRUCTIONS

Big Agnes footprints enable an alternative structure setup; leave the tent body behind and bring your footprint, rainfly, and poles to create a fast and light, open-air shelter. Footprint sold separately.

1. Lay the footprint on the ground and stake out the five cord loops.
2. Assemble the poleset. Ensure each pole section is fully seated into the next by hand instead of allowing the shock cord to snap them together.
3. Position the assembled poleset on top of the footprint, orienting so the colors of the pole ends match the colors of the webbing on the footprint.
4. Insert the pole tips into the keyed slots of the TipLok™ at the head and foot of the footprint.
5. Drape the rainfly over the pole frame, orienting so the webbing colors on the fly match the webbing and TipLok™ on the footprint.
6. Insert the tips of the crossover pole into the "Cross Pole Sockets" located on the underside of the fly.
7. Attach all hook and loop tabs on the underside of the fly to the corresponding pole sections for best stability.
8. Make sure the webbing at the corners of the rainfly is completely slackened. Attach the buckles on the fly to the TipLok™ on the footprint.
9. Tighten the webbing on each buckle as needed to keep the rainfly taut.
10. Stake out both vestibules.
11. Stake out and tension all remaining guylines, completing set up.
